- This anti-bullying training will teach exactly how to teach your child to safely respond to verbal bullying, physical bullying, social bullying, and group manipulation.
- Mr. Bisenius will provide specific strategies for kids that are excluded, shunned, and socially targeted by sophisticated, "popular" bullies operating under adult R.A.D.A.R.
- He specializes in educating youth on how to handle bullying situations through role play, drawings, story- telling and humor.
- He will also cover in detail the body-language techniques that students need to learn in order to react with confidence, and not make the situation worse.

Parents will walk away with concrete tools that they can immediately implement and help their child master in order to eliminate bullying from his or her life. Adults will also learn how to detect truthful statements and techniques for dealing with controlling/intimidating adults in their own lives. Unfortunately many people who bully do not outgrow the behaviors; they simply get older and more subtle.
