## Ross Fenimore Receives First John K. Pfahl Fellow

Ross J. Fenimore of Troop 166, chartered to the Bexley United Methodist Church received the honor of becoming the first John K. Pfahl Fellow on Saturday, June 24, 1995. The fellowship recognizes a Nagatamen staff member who exemplifies the Scout Oath and Law and is a leader on the staff.

The fellowship will also provide scholarship money in the future for participants in the Nagatamen junior leader training program. Nagatamen is an enhanced junior leader training program for youth leaders and future youth leaders in Boy Scout Troops that is held annually in June at Camp Lazarus.

The fellowship is named for the late John K. Pfahl, the council's first Distinguished Eagle Scout. The monies for the fellowship come from a dinner held in his honor last June, where some of the proceeds were put aside to help youth leaders attend training and recognize those youth leaders who returned to train the upcoming youth.
